

Kids Rock Child Care Guidelines

The intent of Kids Rock childcare is to provide a safe place for your children to learn and grow while you (the parent) learn and grow. We hope that Kids Rock will help those attending Celebrating Freedom to participate without distraction. To this end, these guidelines are to be followed:

Initials

- * _____ Children must be potty trained and able to communicate to adults when they need to use the restroom.
- * _____ An information form needs to be completed for each child the first time they attend Kids Rock.
- * _____ All children need to be signed in and have a name tag, regardless of age.
- * _____ Children with food allergies are to have a red star marked on their name tag by their parent.
- * _____ Children must be picked up and signed out by the same parent who dropped them off & signed them in.
- * _____ Children need to be picked up immediately after the small groups are over, no later than 9:00 P.M.
- * _____ Please bring a dinner for your child if they did not have dinner before arriving.
- * _____ Please do not send children with additional snacks or candy.
- * _____ Children with special needs are to be discussed with Kids Rock leadership prior to being brought to KR so that childcare workers are adequately prepared.
- * _____ Children with temperatures may not be brought to KR.
