- 1) Listen. We are made with two ears and one mouth for a reason. So, please listen twice as much as you speak. No interrupting, or speaking when it is someone else's turn.
- 2) Be open & honest. This is a place to learn and make new friends. Friends help each other and tell each other about themselves. This is a place to share good, happy, joyous things that happened during your week and life. This is also a place to share bad, sad, and hurtful things that have happened. Do not tell other friends about what your friends in Kids Rock have said about their problems.
- 3) No cell phones or hand held video games are allowed into class. Leave them at home or with your parent. This is time to interact with people in this class and learn.
- 4) Be respectful. No name-calling. No bad language. No unkind language. Treat others how you want to be treated.
- 5) Stay with the group. For instance, if you are not hungry at dinnertime, then just sit quietly at the table.
- 6) No leaving the classroom until your parents get you / sign you out.
- 7) Ask a teacher to take you if you need to use the restroom.
- 8) There will be no snacks or other food after dinnertime. You must eat with the rest of the group, or not at all. The only drink that you may have after dinner is water.
- 9) Please come to class ready to have fun, learn, and make new friends!

If you break a rule, then you will be put in time out. If you continue to be disruptive, your parent will be retrieved from their class to sign you out.
